

Call for Travel Award Application
Neuro2013
June 20–23, 2013 in Kyoto, Japan

Neuro2013, encompassing the 36th Annual Meeting of the Japan Neuroscience Society (JNS), the 56th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society for Neurochemistry (JSN), and the 23rd Annual Meeting of the Japanese Neural Network Society (JNNS), will be held at the Kyoto International Conference Center from June 20th to 23rd, 2013.

We are working hard to expand this third joint convention of JNS, JSN and JNNS in terms of both content and scale. Recent years have seen remarkable advancements in neuroscience as new methodologies and research paradigms are developed at every level of research, from molecules to genes, cells, neural networks, behavior, theories and neuroscience development. Neuroscience is now rapidly growing beyond basic research in sciences, medicines, pharmacology, engineering and agriculture to incorporate elements of the arts and social sciences. This is an exciting path that will leave a significant mark on society.

Neuro2013 offers Travel Awards to the non-Japanese students and post-docs traveling from abroad to present high quality papers at the meetings. The amount of funding will be depending on the travel distance, and 10 awardees at most. The awardees will also be exempt from the registration fee of the meeting. Those from Asian countries are particularly encouraged. The submission of Travel Award applications should be made before January 15, 2013.
